No. 157. — EXCHANGE OF NOTES BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENTS OF GERMANY AND BULGARIA RELATING TO THE RESUMPTION OF COMMERCIAL RELATIONS. SOFIA. FEBRUARY 19, 1921.

GERMAN LEGATION.

Your Excellency.

Sofia, February 19, 1921.

With reference to the recent negotiations between this Legation and the Royal Ministry of Foreign Affairs, I have the honour to announce that the German and Royal Bulgarian Governments, being desirous that normal commercial and economic relations may be re-established between the two countries, have agreed as follows:

Commercial and economic relations between Germany, on the one hand, and Bulgaria, on the other hand, shall, until August 9, 1921, be based in all respects on the principle of reciprocity and

on the most favoured nation clause.

I beg your Excellency to be so good as to send me your confirmation of this agreement, and have the honour to be, etc.

I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your note No. 198 dated February 19, 1921, in which you were good enough to inform me that the Royal Bulgarian Government and the German

Government, being desirous that normal commercial and economic relations may be re-established

between the two countries, have agreed as follows:

Commercial and economic relations between Bulgaria, on the one hand, and Germany, on the other hand, shall, until August 9, 1921, be based in all respects on the principle of reciprocity and on the most favoured nation clause.
