No. 971. — DECLARATION CONCERNING THE RECIPROCAL RECOGNITION OF TONNAGE-MEASUREMENT CERTIFICATES BY THE REPUBLIC OF LATVIA AND THE UNION OF SOCIALIST SOVIET REPUBLICS, SIGNED AT RIGA, MARCH 19, 1925.

The Government of the Union of Socialist Soviet Republics desirous of regularising the Latvian Government question of the reciprocal recognition of tonnage-measurement certificates, declares its willingness to recognise, on the basis of reciprocity, the tonnage certificates issued in legal form by the Port Administration, Maritime Department of the Latvian Ministry of Finance

the local Bureau for the Technical Inspection, Classification and Registration of Vessels, the local Russian Registration Bureau of the Union of Socialist Soviet Republics or by the local Registration Bureau of the Union of Socialist Soviet Republics.

It also declares its willingness to calculate the harbour dues and other dues levied on vessels calling at Latvian ports under the flag of

Latvia the Union of Socialist Soviet Republics according to the tonnage entered in the certificates referred to, and not to subject such vessels to any remeasurement for the purpose of levying dues.

In the event of the Government of the Union of Socialist Soviet Republics modifying the regula

tions concerning tonnage measurement, the $\frac{\text{Latvian Government}}{\text{Government of the Union of Socialist Soviet Republics}}$ shall be informed of the fact at least three months before the coming into force of these regulations.

The present Declaration shall come into force on the day on which it is signed, and the Government of the Union of Socialist Soviet Republics may denounce it by giving six months'
