No. 1269. — SECOND AGREEMENT SUPPLEMENTARY TO THE CON-VENTION OF SEPTEMBER 1, 1920, BETWEEN GERMANY AND AUSTRIA, CONCERNING ECONOMIC RELATIONS, SIGNED AT BERLIN, MAY 21, 1926.

THE GERMAN REICH and THE AUSTRIAN REPUBLIC have agreed to the following provisions:

Article 1.

Except where hereinafter otherwise stipulated, the provisions of the Convention of September I, 1920, between Germany and Austria concerning economic relations, of the Additional Agreement of July 12, 1924, and of the Agreement dated October 3, 1925, shall remain in force. The present Agreement and the Agreements mentioned above shall form an indivisible whole. The stipulation with regard to denunciation contained in Article 7 of the Additional Agreement of July 12, 1924, shall be applicable.

Article 2.

Austrian products of the soil or industry mentioned in Annex A shall in no case be subject, on importation into German Customs territory, to duties higher than those specified in the said Annex.

The same shall apply to German products of the soil and industry mentioned in Annex B, upon importation into Austrian Customs territory.

Article 3.

The present Agreement shall be ratified. It shall enter into force on the fourteenth day after the exchange of the instruments of ratification, which shall take place at Berlin as soon as possible.

In faith whereof, the Plenipotentiaries have signed the present Agreement at Berlin on May 21, 1926.

In doubtful cases, the German authorities reserve the right to ascertain whether the imported horse really shows the distinctive marks and qualities upon which the reduced tariff depends, and whether its value has been accurately stated.
