SPAIN AND TURKEY

Treaty of Friendship, signed at An-
gora, September 27, 1924.

¹ TRADUCTION. — TRANSLATION.No. 1066. — TREATY ² OF FRIENDSHIP BETWEEN SPAIN AND TURKEY, SIGNED AT ANGORA, SEPTEMBER 27, 1924.

French official text communicated by the Spanish Representative on the Council of the League of Nations. The registration of this Treaty took place January 26, 1926.

TURKEY, of the one part, and SPAIN, of the other part, being equally desirous of establishing and strengthening ties of sincere friendship between the Turkish Republic and the Kingdom of Spain, and equally convinced that such relations between the two States when once established will further the well-being and prosperity of their respective nations, have decided, to conclude a Treaty of Friendship and for this purpose have appointed as their Plenipotentiaries :

THE PRESIDENT OF THE TURKISH REPUBLIC :

His Excellency TEWFIK KIAMIL Bey, Under-Secretary of State in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs ;

HIS MAJESTY THE KING OF SPAIN :

His Excellency Don Juan SERVET Y VEST, His Envoy Extraordinary and Minister Plenipotentiary ;

who, having exchanged their full powers, found in good and due form, have agreed upon the following provisions :

Article 1.

There shall be inviolable peace and sincere and perpetual friendship between the Turkish Republic and the Kingdom of Spain, as well as between the citizens of both Parties.

Article 2.

The High Contracting Parties agree to establish diplomatic relations between the two States in conformity with the principles of international law. They agree that the diplomatic representatives of each of them shall, subject to reciprocity, receive in the territory of the other the treatment recognised by the general principles of public international law.

Article 3.

The present Treaty shall be ratified and the ratifications exchanged at Constantinople as soon as possible. It shall come into force on the 15th day following the exchange of ratifications.

In faith whereof the respective Plenipotentiaries have signed the present Treaty and have thereto affixed their seals.

Done at Angora on September twenty-seven, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-four, in two copies.
