No. 1079. — SUPPLEMENTARY AGREEMENT² TO THE CONVENTION OF JUNE 22, 1923, BETWEEN AUSTRIA AND FRANCE, SIGNED AT PARIS, AUGUST 11, 1924.

French official text communicated by the Prime Minister, Minister for Foreign Affairs of the French Republic. The registration of this Supplementary Agreement took place February 6, 1926.

In pursuance of Article 28 of the Convention dated June 22, 1923, and as a result of the alterations which the Austrian Republic has made in its tariff rates or in the method of levying its duties, THE GOVERNMENT OF THE FRENCH REPUBLIC and THE GOVERNMENT OF THE AUSTRIAN REPUBLIC have decided to amend the provisions of the aforesaid Convention as follows:

(r) The articles enumerated below shall be added to List "A" and shall be given the benefit of the provisions of Article 2.

(4) In the case of the articles enumerated below, the High Contracting Parties shall come to an agreement as to the amounts to be imported:

It is understood that the term "proposed Austrian tariff" which appears in the above provisions shall apply to the draft tariff which is at present before the Austrian Parliament for its approval and which is intended to take the place of the Customs tariff now in force in Austria.

The High Contracting Parties have further decided to define as follows the methods of application of certain provisions of the Convention of June 22, 1923.

(a) As regards the application of Article 2 and the levying of ad valorem duties, the rate of conversion from francs into crowns shall be fixed twice a month according to the mean actual rate as ascertained by the Foreign Exchange Control Office during the preceding fortnight.

(b) In pursuance of Article 2 of the Convention, the Austrian Government shall permit

the importation in barrels of alcoholic liquors entitled to an appellation of origin on condition

that they are decanted in a bonded store under Customs supervision.

(c) As regards the application of Article 9, it shall be understood that the tariff benefits arising out of the Convention dated June 22, 1923, and the present Supplementary Agreement shall be granted to products originating in and coming from Austria, the importation of which is restricted by means of quotas, if the said products are accompanied by a special declaration issued by the Ministry of Commerce and Communications of the Austrian Republic.

When the quotas have reached nine-tenths of their total amount, the French Government

shall inform the Austrian Government of the fact.

Annexed hereto is a specimen form of declaration which will be issued by the Ministry of Commerce and Communications of the Austrian Republic.

These products, in virtue of Article 9 of the said Convention, shall pay at the time of their entry into France import duties at the minimum tariff rates.

The present provision shall annul paragraph 2 of Article I of the Protocol of Signature annexed to the Convention dated June 22, 1923.

(d) The wording of Article 27 of the Convention dated June 22, 1923, shall be modified as follows:

Paragraph 2: delete the words " in conformity with the model annexed to the present Convention and ".

Paragraph 3: add, after the word "legitimation" the words "on the pattern of the aforesaid cards"

The present Supplementary Agreement shall be ratified, and the ratifications shall be exchanged in Paris.

In virtue of the powers which the French legislation confers upon it, the French Government consents that it shall come into force one week after the approval of the Austrian Parliament shall have been notified at Paris.
