No. 1442. — EXTRADITION CONVENTION OF OCTOBER 23, 1872, BETWEEN BELGIUM AND THE GRAND DUCHY OF LUXEMBURG. DECLARATION AMENDING ARTICLE 11 OF THIS CONVENTION. SIGNED AT BRUSSELS, AUGUST 24, 1926.

THE GOVERNMENT OF HIS MAJESTY THE KING OF THE BELGIANS AND THE GOVERNMENT OF HER ROYAL HIGHNESS THE GRAND DUCHESS OF LUXEMBURG, considering it desirable to amend the Extradition Convention of October 23, 1872, in certain points, have agreed, by the present Declaration, as follows:

Article 1.

Article II of the Convention of October 23, 1872, shall be replaced by the following provisions: The extradition, by transit through the respective territories of the Contracting States, of a person who is not a national of the country whose territory is crossed, shall be granted without further formality on the production of the original, or a certified copy, of one of the documents mentioned either in Article 3 of the Convention of October 23, 1872, or in Article I of the Additional Declaration of June 21, 1877, provided that the offence for which extradition was requested is covered by the above-mentioned Convention but does not come under the provisions of Article 8 of the Convention.

Article 2.

Transit expenses shall be defrayed by the State making application.

Article 3.

The present Declaration shall come into force ten days after its publication in the forms laid down by law in the two countries; it shall remain in force for the same period as the Convention of October 23, 1872, and the Additional Declarations of June 21, 1877, April 25, 1893, and November 16, 1899.
