No. 1630. — FRANCO-SAAR DECLARATION ² REGARDING THE CAUTIO JUDICATUM SOLVI. SIGNED AT PARIS, DECEMBER 14, 1927.

French official text communicated by the President of the Saar Territory Governing Commission.

The registration of this Declaration took place January 30, 1928.

The Governing Commission of the Saar Territory and the Government of the French Republic, being desirous of facilitating in future the settlement of actions brought before the French courts by the inhabitants of the Saar and before the Saar courts by French nationals, have agreed upon the following provisions:

Article 1.

Inhabitants of the Saar Basin who bring an action in France or in the French colonies as plaintiffs or interveners shall not be required to make any payment or to furnish any security or deposit other than those to which French nationals are liable, in conformity with French law. "Conversely, French nationals who bring an action in the Saar Territory as plaintiffs or interveners shall not be required to make any payment or to furnish any deposit or security other than those to which the inhabitants of the Saar Basin are liable, in accordance with the laws in force in the Territory.

Article 2.

The same rule shall apply to the payment required of plaintiffs or interveners for the purpose of covering judicial costs, in conformity with Article 85 of the German law concerning legal costs, in force in the Saar Territory.
