No. 2094. — DECLARATION BETWEEN BELGIUM AND ITALY, MODIFYING THE THIRD PARAGRAPH OF ARTICLE 2 OF THE EXTRADITION CONVENTION² OF JANUARY 15, 1875. SIGNED AT BRUSSELS, JANUARY 28, 1929.

French official text communicated by the Belgian Minister for Foreign Affairs. The registration of this Declaration took place July 22, 1929.

THE GOVERNMENT OF HIS MAJESTY THE KING OF THE BELGIANS and THE GOVERNMENT OF HIS MAJESTY THE KING OF ITALY, having thought it expedient to amend the Extradition Convention of January 15, 1875, have agreed by the present Declaration as follows :

Article 1.

In Article 2, paragraph 3, of the aforesaid Convention, the expression " under 14 years of age " shall be replaced by the expression " under 16 years of age."

Article 2.

The present Declaration shall come into force ten days after it has been published in the forms prescribed by the laws of the two countries ; it shall have the same duration as the Convention of January 15, 1875, and the additional Declarations of March 10, 1879³, and December 30, 1881⁴.
