Additional Agreement to the Provisional Economic Treaty between the two Countries, with Final Protocol, signed at Tallinn, June 3, 1931, and Exchange of Notes relating thereto of the same date.

No. 2769. — ADDITIONAL AGREEMENT ² TO THE PROVISIONAL ECONOMIC TREATY BETWEEN ESTONIA AND LATVIA. SIGNED AT TALLINN, JUNE 3, 1931.

French official text communicated by the Estonian Minister for Foreign Affairs. The registration of this Agreement took place July 29, 1931.

The Head of the Republic of Estonia and the President of the Republic of Latvia, being equally desirous of further promoting trade between the two countries in the sense of Article 4 of the Provisional Economic Treaty 3 of March 25, 1928, concluded between Estonia and Latvia, have resolved to conclude an Additional Agreement to the said Treaty and have for this purpose appointed as their Plenipotentiaries:

THE HEAD OF THE ESTONIAN REPUBLIC:

M. Jaan Tõnisson, Minister for Foreign Affairs; and

THE PRESIDENT OF THE LATVIAN REPUBLIC:

M. Charles Zarine, Latvian Envoy Extraordinary and Minister Plenipotentiary at Tallinn;

Who, having communicated their full powers, found in good and due form, have agreed as follows:

Article 1.

Natural or manufactured products originating in and coming from Estonia enumerated in List A annexed to the present Agreement shall, on importation into Latvia, pay the Customs duties mentioned in that List.

The natural or manufactured products originating in and coming from Latvia enumerated in List B annexed to the present Agreement shall, on importation into Estonia, pay the Customs duties mentioned in that List.

Article 2.

The present Additional Agreement shall be ratified and the ratifications shall be exchanged at Riga.

It shall come into force on the day of the exchange of the instruments of ratification and shall remain in force for an indefinite period, each of the High Contracting Parties reserving the right to denounce it at twelve months' notice.

In faith whereof the respective Plenipotentiaries have signed the present Agreement and have thereto affixed their seals.

FINAL PROTOCOL.

On proceeding to sign the Additional Agreement to the Provisional Economic Treaty between Estonia and Latvia, concluded this day, the undersigned Plenipotentiaries made the following declarations, which form an integral part of the Agreement:

(1) As regards the quotas mentioned in Lists A and B, the Government of the country obtaining them shall arrange for allocation.

The Governments of the two countries shall conclude a special agreement regarding the detailed organisation of the formalities relating to the utilisation of the quotas.

- (2) The percentage reductions shown in List B shall refer to the lowest Customs duties applied in future to the respective products of any third country whatsoever, except the countries mentioned in the Final Protocol of the Provisional Economic Treaty of March 25, 1928.
- (3) The privileges reciprocally accorded for Estonian and Latvian cement shall apply only from the date on which the present Latvian Customs duty on cement may
- (4) The privileges reciprocally accorded for Estonian and Latvian sheet glass (§ 77) shall apply only from the coming into force of equal Customs duty rates under the minimum tariffs of both countries; notwithstanding, should the unification of these rates not be brought about, the privileges mentioned in Lists A and B shall come into force on January 1, 1932.
