With reference to Note Verbale No. 26, dated September 17, 1931, the Royal Ministry of Foreign Affairs has the honour to inform the Spanish Legation at Budapest that, in accordance with the principle of reciprocity, the visa for passports for Spanish subjects proceeding to Hungary will also be re-introduced, and that the fee for a visa valid for a single journey will be P. 10, for a transit visa P. 5, and for a visa valid for several journeys, P. 30.
