No. 3454. — PROTOCOL² BETWEEN THE POLISH AND SWEDISH GOVERNMENTS REGARDING COMMERCIAL RELATIONS BETWEEN THE TWO COUNTRIES. SIGNED AT WARSAW, OCTOBER 21ST, 1933.

French official text communicated by the Swedish Minister for Foreign Affairs. The registration of this Protocol took place June 28th, 1934.

The Polish Government and the Swedish Government being desirous of encouraging and developing commercial relations between the two countries, and having regard to the Treaty³ of Commerce and Navigation concluded at Warsaw between Poland and Sweden on December 2nd, 1924, have agreed on the following provisions:

- (1) The Polish Customs duties mentioned in the attached list (Annex A) shall not for a period of six months from November 1st, 1933 exceed the amounts given in that list.
- (2) If Sweden should increase the Customs duties mentioned in the attached list (Annex B), during the period of six months referred to, or if, during the said period, Customs duties should be imposed in Sweden on goods mentioned in the attached list and at present free of duty, the Polish Government shall be entitled to ask the Swedish Government to enter immediately into negotiations.

Should these negotiations not lead to a positive result within three weeks of the date of the submission of the Polish Government's request, the Polish Government may withdraw all or part of the tariff concessions mentioned in the list forming Annex A to the present Protocol.

- (3) The same shall apply if the Swedish Government should introduce new provisions as regards the import of coal into Sweden during the same period.
- (4) The present Protocol shall be ratified and the instruments of ratification shall be exchanged at Stockholm as soon as possible.

It shall come into force on the date of the exchange of the instruments of ratification and shall remain in force until May 1st, 1934.

If, one month before the expiration of this period, neither of the two Governments has announced its intention to annul the Protocol, or to enter into negotiations with a view to its amendment, the Protocol shall be deemed to continue in force for an indefinite period and may be denounced at any time. In the event of denunciation, it shall remain in force for one month from the date on which one of the two Governments has notified the other of its intention to terminate the Protocol.
