No. 3780. — AGREEMENT ² BETWEEN THE NETHERLANDS AND POLAND REGARDING CUSTOMS TARIFFS. SIGNED AT THE HAGUE, DECEMBER 11TH, 1933.

French official text communicated by the Netherlands Minister for Foreign Affairs. The registration of this Agreement took place November 27th, 1935.

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE NETHERLANDS

and

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE POLISH REPUBLIC,

Being equally desirous of promoting the reciprocal exchange of goods between their respective countries, have decided to conclude an Agreement concerning Customs Tariffs and to that end have appointed as their Plenipotentiaries:

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE NETHERLANDS:

Jonkheer Andries Cornelis DIRK DE GRAEFF, Minister for Foreign Affairs; and

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE POLISH REPUBLIC:

Monsieur Waclaw Babiński, Envoy Extraordinary and Minister Plenipotentiary of Poland accredited to Her Majesty the Queen of the Netherlands;

Who, having communicated their full powers, found in good and due form, have agreed on the following provisions:

Article I.

The Government of the Polish Republic undertakes to apply to such products originating in and coming from the Netherlands as are enumerated in List A, annexed to the present Agreement, the Customs treatment specified in the said List.

Article 2.

The Government of the Netherlands undertakes to apply to such products originating in and coming from the Polish Customs territory as are enumerated in List B, annexed to the present Agreement, the Customs treatment specified in the said List.

Article 3.

In the event of one of the Contracting Parties being led to impose duties, or to increase one or more existing duties, on the products specified in Lists A and B respectively, the said Party shall

notify the other Party accordingly not less than fifteen days before the imposition or increase of the

duty or duties in question.

Failing equivalent concessions, that Party which in its own judgment is the sufferer by the duties aforementioned shall be entitled to withhold some part of the concessions accorded by it under the present Agreement.

Article 4.

The imposition by one of the Contracting Parties, after the signature of the present Agreement, of duties on imported products as a counterpart to internal dues or taxes shall not be deemed to be an infraction of the provisions of the present Agreement.

Article 5.

The present Agreement shall be ratified and the instruments of ratification shall be exchanged at Warsaw as soon as possible. It shall come into force on the thirtieth day from the date of the exchange of the instruments of ratification, and shall remain in force until December 15th, 1934. It shall be prolonged by tacit consent, but may be denounced at any time after September 15th, 1934, by notice given three months beforehand.

In faith whereof the above-named Plenipotentiaries have signed the present Agreement and have thereto affixed their seals.
