No. 3832. — PROTOCOL ² BETWEEN ESTONIA AND LATVIA REGARD-ING THE INTERPRETATION OF THE CONVENTION³ OF NOVEMBER 14TH, 1935, BETWEEN ESTONIA, LATVIA AND LITHUANIA CONCERNING THE RECIPROCAL RECOGNITION AND ENFORCEMENT OF JUDGMENTS IN CIVIL MATTERS. SIGNED AT KAUNAS, NOVEMBER 14TH, 1935.

French official text communicated by the Latvian Minister for Foreign Affairs. The registration of this Protocol took place February 14th, 1936.

On proceeding to-day to sign the Convention concerning the reciprocal recognition and enforcement of judgments in civil matters, the undersigned, being duly authorised, declare that the above-mentioned Convention shall in no way affect the provisions of Article 3, paragraph 2, of the Convention between Estonia and Latvia regarding the registration of immovable property signed at Riga on July 22nd, 1927, which reads as follows:

"The judgments of the courts of either of the Contracting Parties with regard to liabilities and claims entered in the registers of the two States shall be executed in the other State, in virtue of paragraphs 1274 to 1280 of the Code of Civil Procedure."

In faith whereof the Plenipotentiaries have signed the present Protocol and have thereto affixed their seals.
