YOUR EXCELLENCY.

HELSINKI, March 25th, 1938.

The Governments of Hungary and Latvia being desirous of promoting tourist traffic between the two countries, I have the honour to inform Your Excellency that the Royal Hungarian Government agrees to abolish the fees for visas granted to Latvian nationals, while maintaining the obligation to obtain a visa and the office charges therefor. These charges are fixed as follows:

It is understood that the Government of the Republic of Latvia for its part agrees to reduce the charges for visas at present in force in Latvia in respect of Hungarian nationals in accordance with the following scale :

1. Simple transit visa with right to stay three days, including the days of entry into and departure from Latvia . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . Ls. 1.60

## MONSIEUR LE MINISTRE.

The Governments of Latvia and Hungary being desirous of promoting tourist traffic between the two countries, I have the honour to inform Your Excellency that the Government of Latvia for its part agrees to reduce the visa charges at present in force in Latvia for Hungarian nationals in accordance with the following scale:

It is hereby understood that the Royal Hungarian Government for its part agrees to abolish the fees for visas granted to Latvian nationals, while maintaining the obligation to obtain a visa and the office charges therefor. These charges are fixed as follows:

P. 3.—

4. If the visa is affixed to a passport subsequently, that is after entry into Hungary, the holder will also be charged a supplementary fee of P. 0.50.

The present Agreement shall come into force as from April 15th, 1938.

Requesting Your Excellency to be so good as to send me confirmation of the Royal Hungarian Government's agreement to these provisions, I avail myself of this opportunity, etc.
